



Best of South-East Scholarship

Best of South East is a scholarship-programme initiated by the **Steiermärkische Sparkasse**, in cooperation with **Montanuniversitaet Leoben**, University of Graz, University of Music and Performing Arts Graz and TU Graz. It is an advancement and continuing education programme for talented and dedicated students from **Slovenia**, **Croatia**, **Bosnia** and **Herzegovina**, **Serbia**, **Montenegro** and **Macedonia**.

The scholarship programme lasts 12 months (from September to the end of August) and includes at *Montanuniversitaet Leoben (MUL):*

- 1. A scholarship of <u>750€ monthly</u> for an entire year (sponsored by Stmk Sparkasse)
- 2. A scholarship for a 2-semester mobility programme at Montanuniveristaet Leoben (winter and summer semesters)
- 3. A 2-month trainee programme or internship (in July and August)

The programme's aim is to provide scholarship-holders with **international education**, work experience and training opportunities. Scholarship-holders benefit greatly from the BoSE- programme in multiple ways:



- Academic added value from studying at *MUL*
- Career facilitation through an international internship
- Enhancement of your chances on the job market through studying and working abroad

During the scholarship programme **events** and **informative meetings** ensure that scholarship-holders are integrated into the economic, cultural and scientific life in Styria. On order to improve your language skills German and English language courses can be attended.

Application Requirements

- Citizenship: Slovenian, Bosnian and Herzegovinian, Croatian, Serbian, Montenegro or the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (F.Y.R.O.M)
- The applicant must be enrolled as regular student in a university abroad or at MUL
- Language skills in English (level B2) or German (level B2)
- Students need to have completed at least 4 semesters of their Bachelor program by the time of the application
- Very good grades
- Doctoral students require a letter of confirmation from the supervisor of your dissertation at *Montanuniversitaet Leoben* (our office can help you to find a supervisor at MUL)
- Motivation, commitment, good communication skills, adaptability, theoretical knowledge, as well as practical skills







Application Process

Step 1: Request the link to the online application platform at MIRO

Send an application request to <u>christina.cresnik@unileoben.ac.at</u> and you will receive the link to our MUL online application platform. You should do this a minimum of 14 days before the application deadline ends in order to apply via the platform in due time! \rightarrow The online application will close on December 8th!

Please, be so kind as to include the following information in the application email:

- First and last name (as in your passport)
- Name of your home university in both the native language and in English
- Your academic programme (BA, MA, Diploma, Dr. etc.) and in which semester of your programme you are currently in

Step 2: Collect the Application Documents

- Confirmation of enrolment from the applicant's home university
- **Motivation letter** in the form of an essay (not exceeding 2 pages); the focus of the essay should be on the applicant's individual interests and motivation
- **Transcript of Records / Diploma Certificate** (if the original is in a language other than English or German, a translation in English or German certified by the home university is necessary):
 - For Master's students: Bachelor's degree certificate and transcript of records from the Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes
 - For PhD students: Bachelor's and Master's degree certificates, as well as the transcript of records from the Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral degree programmes
- **2 letters of recommendation**: Both letters of recommendation must be written by teachers who taught or supervised the applicant during his/her degree programme. One of the two letters of recommendation must be issued by an academic.
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form (in English or German)
- Copy of your passport
- **Proof of German or English language skills:** Language certificates may not be older than one year.
 - German language skills (at least level B2); only official certificates from the ÖSD, Goethe Institute or universities will be accepted
 - English language skills (at least level B2); only official certificates will be accepted

Step 3: Apply via our online application platform
